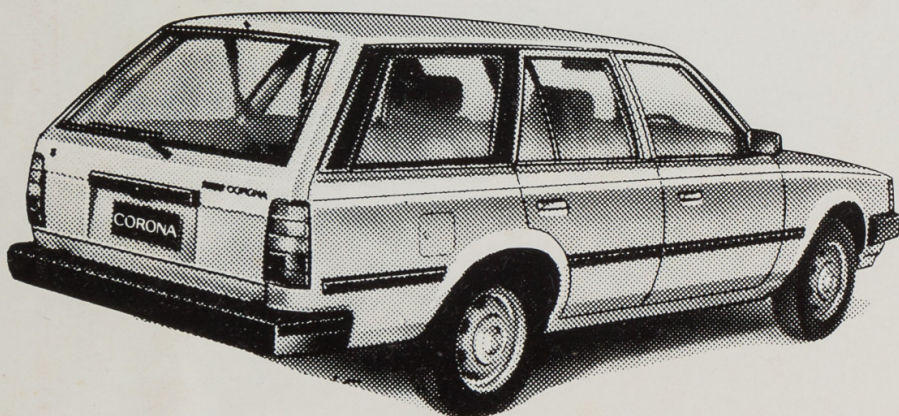
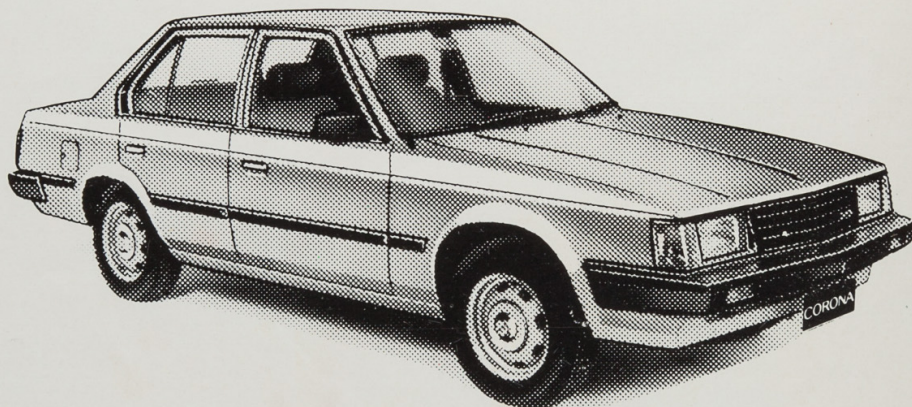

Renee has continued to write and a number of her works will be recorded shortly.

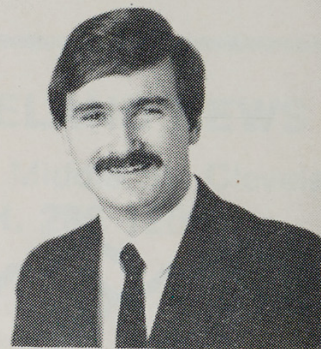
The Redland Shire Band presents Renee Laycock for your enjoyment.

SHIRE CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE


I am delighted to once again have the opportunity to bring a greeting to the guests who are attending this Concert being presented by the "Redland Shire Band".

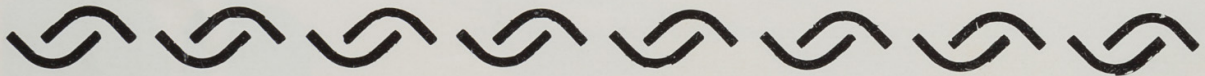
As Chairman of the Redland Shire Council I have been impressed with the progress and the development of the band since its formation in 1984. As Patron I knew they would be equal to the task.

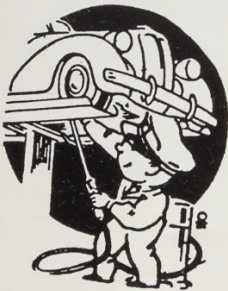

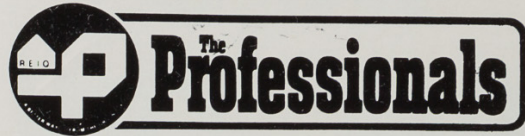
