At that meeting, it became evident that the Redland Shire Council, through chairman, Merv Genrich and other councillors, were right behind such a project, and rehearsals commenced the following week in the council rooms, Bloomfield Street, Cleveland.

Publicity in the Redland Times and the Redland Local News resulted in the band which you hear tonight. Some players from the original band have rejoined in Vince Boughen and Dan Lammas, and as well, a lot of talent has been discovered in the Redlands and surrounding areas.

The main aim of the band is to bring music in the form of a brass band to the Redland Shire, and to amalgamate with other forms of entertainment for community enjoyment.

Proceeds from this concert will be put to good use in paying for the instruments which we have kindly had "on loan" from Legato Pty Ltd (Melbourne). As further instruments are purchased we will be forming a learners group. (Enquiries to David Tasker-Irvine Phone 206 3272).

Concerts proposed for the future include a joint venture with the Redland Shire/RSL Pipe Band and a possible joint concert with the Redland Organ Society.


