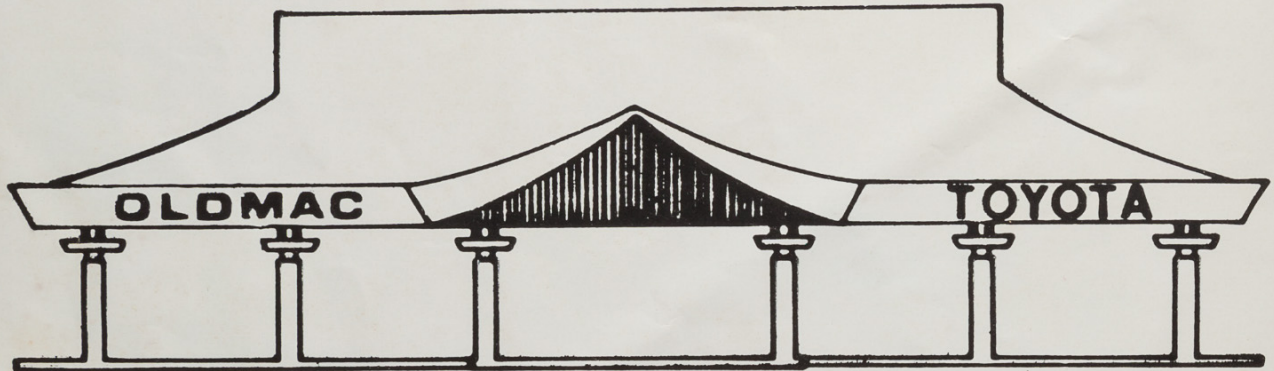

Bill is currently President of the Brisbane Ring for the famous International Brotherhood of Magicians.

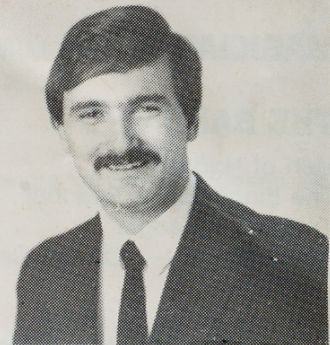
In work-a-day life he is an English Master at Brisbane's famous "Churchie" Anglican Grammar School — hope our programme passes, Bill!!

We are sure you will enjoy the contrast of some "sleight of hand" from Bill.

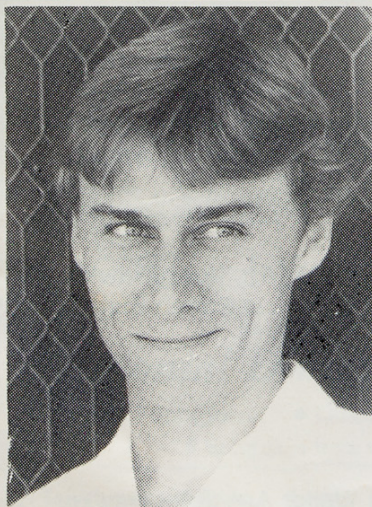

May I welcome each one of you and trust that you will enjoy the professional programme that the band will present.


It seems so long ago since the band was formed, and yet our records show that it is just two years. During that time, our band has met with huge success and has brought credit to this Shire.
