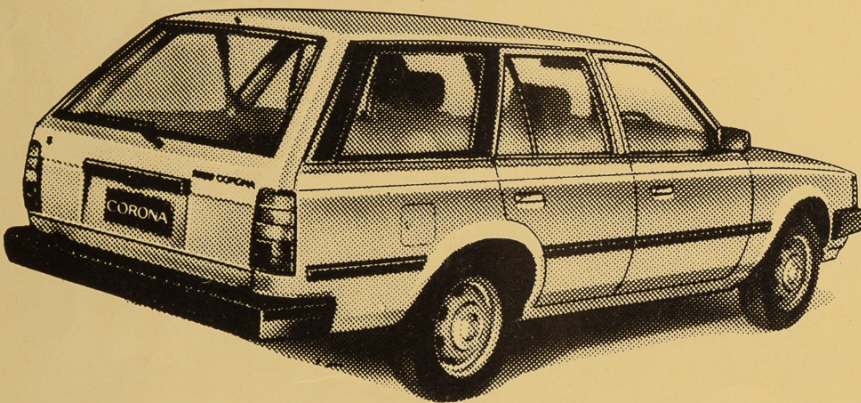
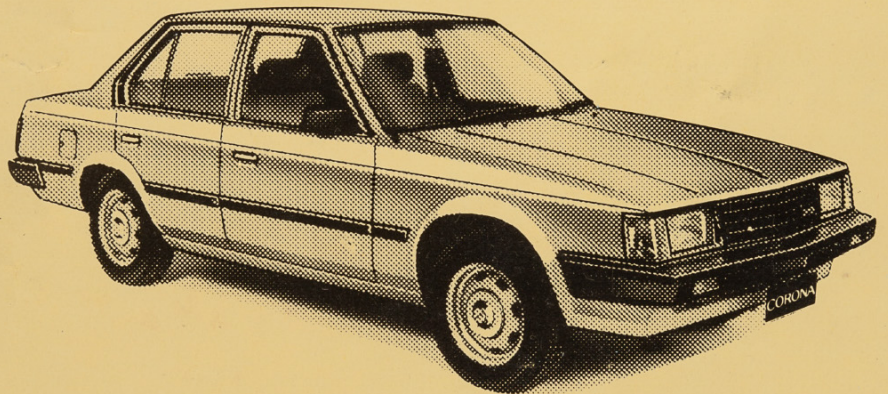

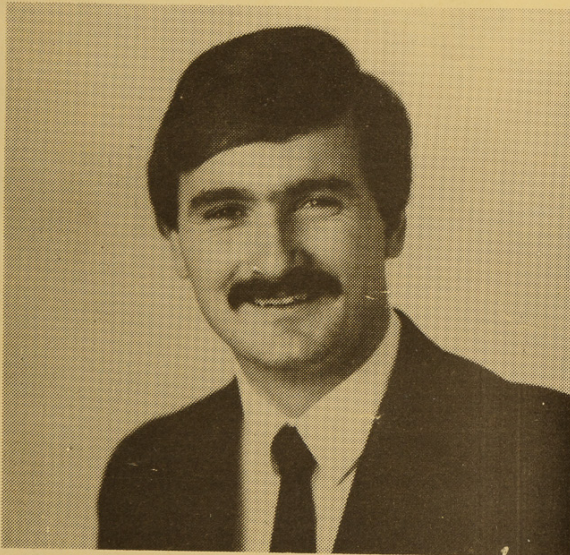


**Guest Vocalist: PAUL NEAL**

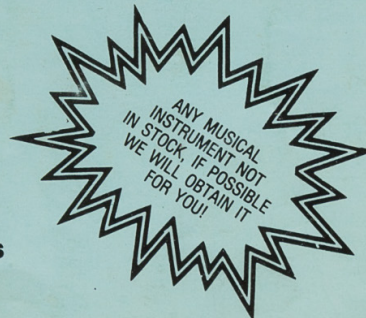
